I agree to bear all risk and expense for any loss, theft, or damage to my paintings or other personal property or injury to my person, regardless of cause. I indemnify and hold harmless Hermosa Arts and History Association (Haha), the City of Hermosa, South Dakota, from and against, any claim, suit, action liability or expense arising out of any matter which would result from my participation, exhibiting or using images of my paintings for publicity.

Haha reserves the right to accept or not accept any painting for exhibit. The participating artists and all paintings submitted may be photographed and/or videoed by Haha for promotional purposes.

As a participating artist, I certify that all Haha event artwork I submit for sale is my original work painted "en plein air" and produced only during the published dates of this event. Event artwork must be created outdoors in front of the subject depicted in the work. Work not completed outdoors and in front of the subject will not be hung. Homework paintings are not eligible for awards.

I agree that Haha Event paintings produced from photographs, from manipulated photographic processes, computer enhanced imagery, or any other non-plein air means are prohibited during this event. This prohibition also includes false fronts on canvases and digital canvas prints painted over to appear as an original plein air painting.

I understand that only blank canvases/papers will be allowed to be stamped at the Hermosa Arts and History Association Museum, 25 N. Second St., Hermosa, SD. The stamps must then be visible on the backs of the finished paintings when they are framed and hung at the sales venue. Tinted surfaces are permitted at the time of stamping.

I understand that any painting I show at the event, must be properly framed and ready to hang. Gallery wraps will not be permitted. This applies to all artwork hung during the event.

I understand that sales are handled by the artist, not HAHA. Because HAHA wants to display your art, sales are not allowed off the easel until the end of the event. If an artist cannot stay until the end of the event, HAHA is willing to accept payment on behalf of the artist and send art with the buyer. Arrangements must be made ahead of time on how artist is to receive payment. No funds will run through HAHA accounts. Artist is responsible for collecting, reporting and paying South Dakota Sales Tax (4.2%), Hermosa City Tax (2.0%) and Tourism Tax (1.5%).

Artists who sell will receive 100% of the total selling price of their paintings from the sale of their artwork. However, a free will donation to HAHA would be appreciated. HAHA is a 501(c)3 non-profit. Donations are tax deductible as law allows.
